## WORKING HOURS AND BREAKS

Work begins: 9:00am Morning Break: 10:30 – 10:45am Lunch Break: 12:30 – 1:00pm Afternoon Break: 2:30 – 2:45pm Finish: 4:00pm

You need to bring a packed lunch, but tea, coffee and fruit squash are provided at all break times. Please let us know about any dietary needs, e.g. dairy free products.



# ILLNESS AND ABSENCE

If you are ill or going to be absent please contact the office before 9am. You are required to have up-to-date tetanus cover before starting at Horticap.

### DISCIPLINE

Foul language, bullying, violence or any abuse will not be tolerated.

### **NO SMOKING**

It is illegal for anyone to smoke within any enclosed or substantially enclosed area on the nursery or areas accessible to the public. A designated smoking area is provided.

# NAMED RESPONSIBLE CONTACT PERSON

A named responsible contact person must be recorded on individual student records.

### HOLIDAYS

You may take up to 4 weeks holiday. Please notify us well in advance. In addition to all Bank Holidays we close between Christmas and New Year. We may also be closed occasionally for staff training; sufficient notice will be given.

## CLOTHING

This is a most important aspect of working at the nurseries. During the winter it can be very cold outside and uncomfortable if you are not suitably dressed.

#### <u>Winter</u>

One thick layer is not enough, lots of layers are better (e.g. vest, T-shirt, jumper, waterproof coat) with hat and gloves. Safety working boots are provided.

#### <u>Summer</u>

You should always bring a coat. In hot weather necks may burn so you need a collar, a sunhat and sun cream.
